Technical and Performance Requirements

Technical requirements:

- A minimum of one hour is required to set up the hall and 45 minutes to clear away without anyone else being in the hall at that time. Performance running time is one hour.
- The play is specifically designed to be performed in a school hall and **not on a stage**. (Ideal space requirement 16m x 14m).

Please contact TSF office if your hall dimensions fall short of this to discuss if the space is large enough.

- Curtains or blinds in performance space to darken the room
- Access to 13 amp power sockets.

Seating Arrangements:

- Please check that you have enough space and that you are able to provide seating in a tiered arrangement of mats, benches and chairs so that all the pupils can see (see floor and seating plan for layout of seating).
- Maximum number of pupils per performance is 130. Unless previously agreed in the booking process, TSF reserves the right to refuse to perform if the numbers on the day exceed this limit.

Performance requirements:

- The play is designed for pupils who are learning French: ages 6-11.
- The performance lasts one hour you will need to allow time for children to come in and leave the hall on top of the performance and set up time.
- Please do not allow people to walk through the hall during the performance.

- Please could teaching staff organise the pupils entering the performance space and seat them rather than leaving it to the TSF company.
- Please ensure that teaching staff are in the hall at all times during the performance.
- Please ensure there are no interruptions during the performance could all mobile phones be switched off.
- Please note that videoing or taking photographs during the performance is not allowed. Photographs can be taken at the end of the show if sufficient time.

DBS Clearance

Please note wherever possible TSF seeks to obtain DBS clearance for all actors
and stage managers working in schools. However this is not possible in all cases
as we like to employ native French speakers in our productions many of whom
still live in their country of origin. The DBS system can only check records for
people living in the UK. In this particular production, only one of the two
actors will be carrying a DBS certificate. If you have any questions about this,
please contact the TSF office (01434 603114).

IMPORTANT:

For health and safety reasons please ensure there are no pupils in the hall whilst the company are setting up or whilst they are taking down the set at the end of the performance.

If you are unable to meet any of these requirements please contact the TSF office to discuss possible alternative arrangements (01434 603114).

Cancellation Policy

In the event of the school requesting to cancel the booking as set out on the booking form:

- within 14 days prior to the agreed date(s), the full fee will still be payable**
- within 15 28 days prior to the agreed date(s), half the full fee will be payable**
- over 28 days prior to the agreed date(s), no fee will be payable

[** unless a replacement booking can be found]

In the event of TSF having to cancel the booking (e.g. illness/injury to actors) we will endeavour to find an alternative date for the performance which is convenient for the school. If payment has already been made and an alternative date cannot be found TSF will refund the total amount.
